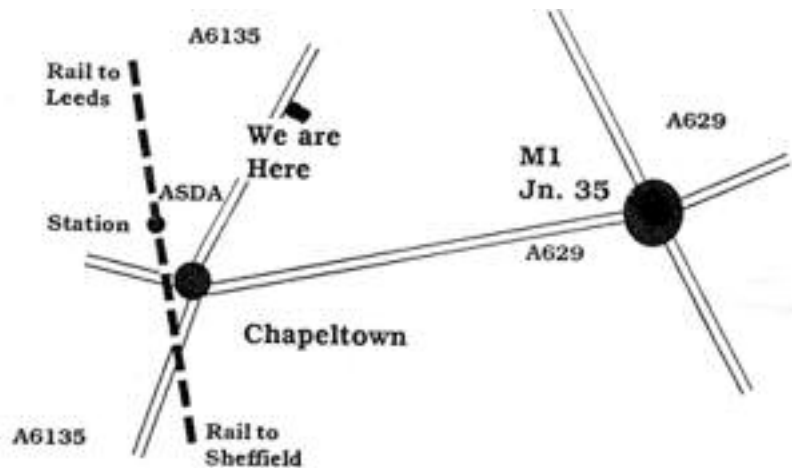

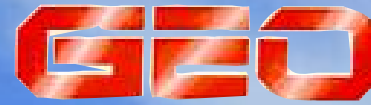

- All orders for delivery within the UK by Royal Mail or carrier (currently Business Post) are carriage paid, provided the order amounts to a minimum of £300.00 (ex.VAT).
- Orders below £300.00 will be charged £10.00 +VAT as a standard charge or £5.00+VAT if the total weight is not more than 1kg. (Certain large, low weight items may be charged at the standard rate.)
- Next day, and other special services are available, please ask for a quote.

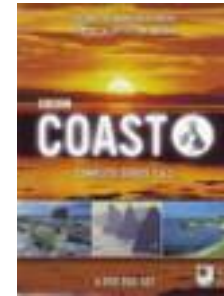

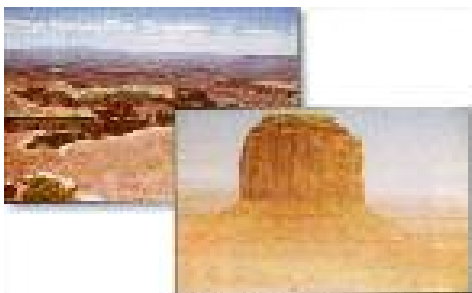

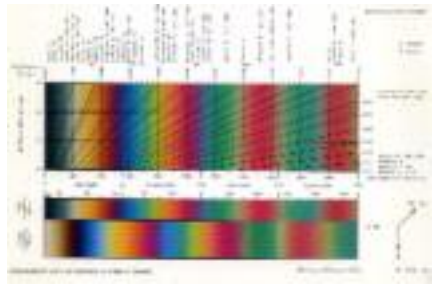
