### INTRODUCTION TO THE COURSE...

We began our look at aspects of British geology under the title "Time Traveller's Britain" back in 2015. We ran three series of 10-Units in each course. Some the original course Units featured pioneer geologists and linked them to specific areas of the British Isles, whilst others were plain geographic areas. In these live Zoom sessions we've taken the concept to a new level, enabling both Chris and Colin to share their real field experiences with you in six specially chosen parts of the UK. These are all places that Chris and in most cases Colin, have visited in recent years.
